## Esoteric Hypnosis Training Academy® Code of Ethics

The Code of Ethics sets out the standards expected of all practitioners of the Esoteric Hypnosis Training Academy®, for the guidance of practitioners. Practitioners of the Academy are expected to inform all clients, prospective, present and former of the Code of Ethics and how to access it online. The Code of Ethics must be made visible to clients either by being displayed in the place of practice where in person sessions take place, and/or digitally online.

1. Practitioner holds the welfare of clients central to their work and so commits to avoiding harm.
2. Practitioner endeavours to establish trust with their clients and the community in which they work. The practitioner conducts themselves at all times in accord with their professional status, in a respectful, professional, and ethical manner.
3. Practitioner works in ways that promote client autonomy and well-being and that maintain respect and dignity for the client.
4. Practitioner is aware of their own judgements based on their own experiences. This means showing respect for diversity of persons, without prejudice.
5. Practitioner works with integrity and self-responsibility, they work to be as honest, truthful, and accurate as possible. They are also responsible for looking after their own needs and health.
6. Practitioner respects the status of all other medical/healthcare professionals and the boundaries of their professional remit.
7. Practitioner provides a service to clients in areas in which they are trained and competent to do so and will not work outside their scope of practice.
8. Practitioner remains aware of their own limitations and wherever appropriate, be prepared to refer a client to another practitioner or medical adviser who might offer suitable support/treatment.
9. Practitioner maintains strict confidentiality within the client relationship, always provided that such confidentiality is neither inconsistent with the practitioner's own safety or the safety of the client.
10. Practitioner ensures that client notes and records be kept secure and confidential.
11. Practitioner provides services in the context of professional business arrangements and establishes fees and payment arrangements clearly understood by clients.
12. Practitioner ensures that all advertising, no matter in what form or medium it is placed, represents a truthful, honest and accurate picture of themselves.
13. Practitioner displays only valid qualifications and certificates issued in respect of relevant training courses and accreditation as issued or awarded by relevant professional bodies.
14. Practitioner ensures that the premises where the session takes place and all facilities offered to clients are safe, hygienic and appropriate for the service provided.
15. Practitioner will not offer any guarantee as to the effectiveness or outcome of any treatment.
16. Practitioner provides clients with informed consent at the outset of the session.
17. Practitioner does not cross the boundaries appropriate to the therapeutic relationship. This includes, but not limited to: having sexual relationships with or behaving sexually towards clients, or by exploiting them emotionally, financially or in any other way whatsoever.
18. Practitioner does not touch the client in any way that may be open to misinterpretation. Touch always requires a request and explanation and permission to be granted from the client.
19. Practitioner ensures if the client is a child under the age of 16, another person should always be present. This may be someone with parental responsibility.
20. Practitioner ensures that wherever a client is seeking assistance for the relief of physical or mental symptoms, that unless having already done so, the client is advised to consult a registered medical practitioner. The practitioner should not attempt to diagnose physical or mental symptoms unless they have undergone relevant medical training in diagnostics.
21. Practitioner is to abide by the Statutes and common laws applicable to their place of practice.
